Job Description

The CND Engineer will provide expert consultation across a wide range of cross-functional areas of Cybersecurity (CS) services in support of a Department of Defense Mission. The CND Engineer will provide project planning, guidance and technical expertise in the following areas: program, policy, process, planning, auditing, and quality planning and control. Provide lead Program Office (PO) engineering to the Computer Network Defense (CND) program and the Capabilities APM.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Support the ONE-Net Enterprise Configuration Control Board (ECCB) as the program office's voting member. Review Requests for Change (RFC) monthly, and develop CND specific RFCs on behalf of the program office
- Lead Joint Information Environment (JIE) Joint Regional Security Stack (JRSS) engineering efforts, and participate in all weekly and bi-weekly Integrated Product Teams (IPTs).
- Maintain status of all program office Installation Processing Node Security Stack (IPN SS) integrations, CONUS peering and migrations, and maintenance of Navy Tactical requirements with the Tactical Processing Node (TPN)
- Support all cross platform/program office engineering efforts. This includes support to multiple program office Technical Exchange Meetings (TEM)

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engineering sessions with the program office and the Navy Cyber Defense Operations Command (NCDOC), and any other ad hoc meetings as needed

- Maintain the CND Roadmap
- Identify any engineering roadblocks that hinder the CND Priority and Execution lists, and provide regular updates to all CND priority/execution list items
- Maintain the CND product End of Life/Support (EOL/S)
- Develop engineering artifacts, as needed, in support of Capabilities APM, i.e. CND Capabilities Working/Steering Group (CCW/SG), CND architecture drawings, POM engineering issues, etc.
- Provide Configuration Management (CM) support to the program office Configuration Control Board. Review CND Engineering Change Requests (ECR) and associated documentation, and prepare Platform Technical Review Board (PTRB) recommendations
- Provide Cybersecurity engineering expertise, as necessary, across the program office portfolio.

Education and Qualifications

- Must have one of the certifications, a current CISSP, CISM, or GSLC to meet the baseline requirements for IAM III level under 8570.01M.
- Additional computer environment certifications like Server 2012, UNIX Solaris 10, CCNA-Security, CCNA-Voice, CCNP, and MCP are a plus.
- Must possess working knowledge of Assessment and Authorization practices within DoDI8510.01, ICD 503, CNSSI 1253, and the Risk Management Framework (RMF) process including various security tools (ACAS, HBSS, etc).
- Minimum of 8-10 years of related experience.
- Must have an **Active Secret security clearance**.
