Assist the ONE-NET staff in migrating C&A/A&A activities from DIACAP to RMF and implementing DoD provided automated tools (e.g. eMASS).
- Provide subject matter expertise to ONE-NET commands for DoD IA policy directives, programs and procedures, C&A/A&A, Cross Domain Solutions, NIPRNet and SIPRNet connection approval process and other DoD / Navy IA program elements for all ONE-NET Operational GENSER networks, applications, and systems. Field questions and inquiries related to DoD/Navy IA and IAWF programs, C&A/A&A documentation and C&A/A&A processes.
