- IAW NIST SP 800-53A, document weakness as well associated risks assessments to identify weaknesses and recommend and implement corrective actions as part of A&A and continuous monitoring activities to include annual assessments, POA&M management, etc. using an automated RMF A&A tool.
- Possess the skills necessary to perform assess the effectiveness of the implementation of DISA STIGs with regards to platforms and applications.
- Must have the ability to communicate effectively in writing and verbally.
- Ability to work effectively independently and as part of a group.
- Possess the knowledge and experience required to assist in the development of cybersecurity related documentation and other artifacts required to successfully navigate an information system through the DoD/Navy acquisition process.

- The candidate will have knowledge and ability to assess system compliance with DISA STIGs at the network, platform and application levels.

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- Must have knowledge of and experience with the implementation of DoD RMF policies, standards and guidance employed to obtain IATTs, and ATOs.
- The candidate will have experience with using the automated RMF Assessment and Authorizations (A&A) tools to complete and document RMF A&As.
- The candidate will possess knowledge needed to successfully complete DoD compliant RMF continuous monitoring activities, to include annual control assessments, POA&M monitoring and updates, creation and/or updating of security documentation, development of mitigations for non-fully compliant controls.
