- Provide oversight for shore and shipboard program installation for afloat units, within the Integrated Shipboard Network Systems (ISNS)
- Coordinate efforts with SSC Engineers and ISEA points of contact to ensure SPAWAR/PEO Integrated Data Environment and Data Repository (SPIDER) Navy Data Environment (NDE) entries were made for specific ship installations

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- Provide oversight over training efforts between the SPAWAR Program Office Training APM, NAVIVOR, Training Development and Support Center (TDSC) and training instructors to ensure Fleet Sailors and Government employees acquire needed CND-OSE product maintenance and sustainment training
